Hebrews 1:1-4; 2:5-12

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is far more important than anything of anybody else, even than prophets or angels. Through him who has become human and died like we do, humankind has become what God meant it to be from the beginning.

Mark 10:2-16

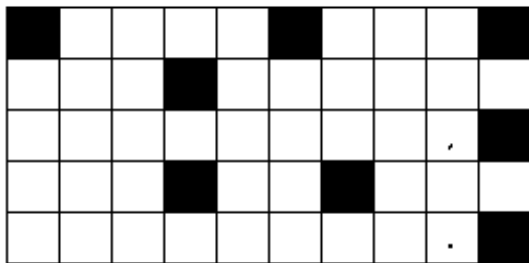

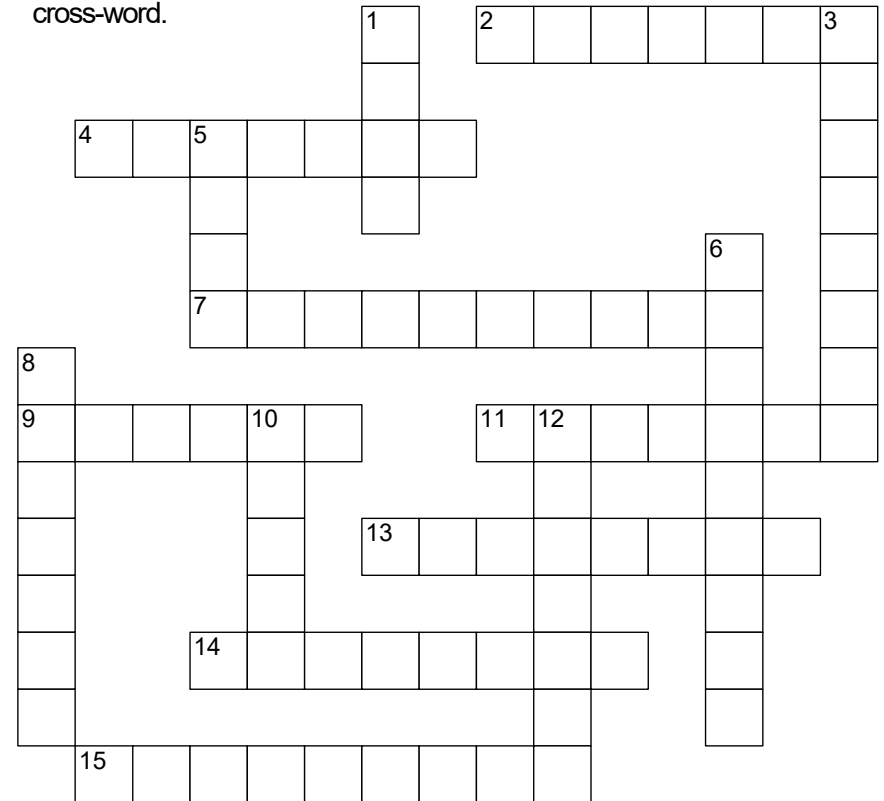
