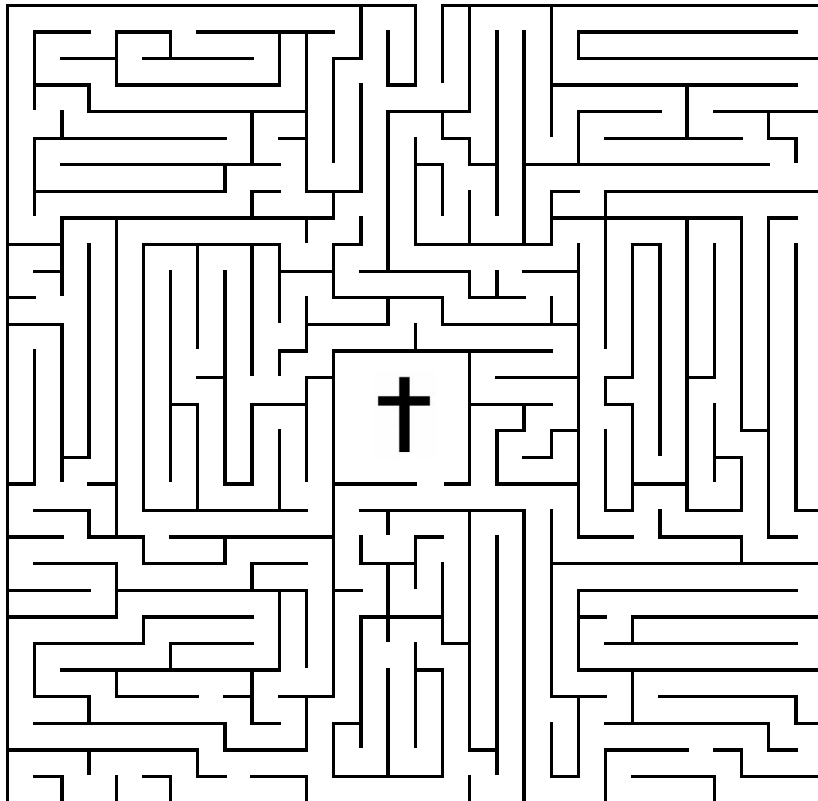


Where is God now?



Job is searching for God far and wide to bring his case before him. But God does not want to be found at the moment. Go with Job on his search! You'll find God on the cross...

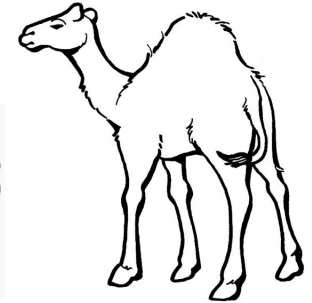
